

Code of Conduct

The Court is a venue to be enjoyed by all, regardless of sexuality. Therefore we ask that when you visit our venue you practice acceptance and celebration of this diversity by abiding by the following Code of Conduct:

1. Please treat all staff and patrons with the respect they deserve. Any form of abuse, be it verbal or physical, is not tolerated in our venue and if you chose to participate in unacceptable behaviour you will be asked to leave the venue.
2. If you are asked to leave the venue it is not because of your sexuality, it is usually due to your behaviour or to your level of intoxication. If you feel you have been asked to leave in error please ask at the door to see the manager on duty or the head crowd controller. Patrons that refuse to leave the venue upon request are committing an offense and may be denied future access to the venue.
3. Female patrons found in the male toilets will be removed from the premises and vice versa. Exceptions are made for people transitioning between genders, or if you identify strongly towards one gender over the other. Please use the bathroom you feel most suits your personal identity. If you are removed and you feel it has been done in error please ask to see our head crowd controller or the manager on duty and calmly explain that you are transitioning or are identifying in that direction.
4. We do not tolerate sleazy behaviour in the venue. If someone refuses your advances please do not continue to approach that person. If you are being harassed by a patron please let our door staff or managers know so we can deal with the person. We are very good at giving lessons in Court etiquette.
5. Parents, if you do choose to enjoy our venue with your children, please note we encourage you to take them home before 8pm. Management may ask you to leave with them after this time. Children must be fully supervised by you at all times.
6. As required under the Liquor Licensing Act, at the Court Hotel:
 - We will not allow you to enter the premises or receive service at the bars if you are intoxicated. If you are in danger of becoming intoxicated, we will ask you to leave the venue.
 - We will not allow you to enter or remain on the premises if you are under the age of 18 years unless you are under the constant supervision of a parent or legal guardian. After 8pm we require all juveniles to leave the venue.
 - We will not serve alcohol to anyone under the age of 18 years. You must be able to produce valid and current proof of age upon request from our staff, management or security. The three acceptable forms of identification are:
 - i. A Current Australian driver's license with a photograph.
 - ii. A Western Australian proof of age card (18+) issued by the DPI
 - iii. A current valid passport with a photograph.
 - iv. **NO OTHER FORMS OF ID WILL BE ACCEPTED**
7. If you are driving please do not drink. We have food available and we also provide a range of non and low alcoholic beverages. We are more than happy to call a taxi on request. Free water is available at all bars.
